## **Annual Asbestos Notification**

This is to inform you of the status of the Costa Catholic Academy Asbestos Management Plan. It has been determined by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency that asbestos is a potential health hazard, and precautions should be taken to avoid disturbing any asbestos containing materials. The AHERA law requires that a visual surveillance of asbestos containing areas be completed every six months, and a reinspection conduction every three years. Any evidence of disturbance or change in condition of asbestos continuing materials is documented in the Asbestos Management Plan, which is available for review in the school office.
